- Offers courses in the science and history of aviation, the exploration of space, global cultural studies, survival skills, leadership, citizenship, communication, wellness, college and career planning, precision military drill, etc.
- Available to students of eight Delaware County high schools.
- All courses receive elective credit in all eight participating schools.
- Qualifies for the Physical Education Waiver.
- All Cadets are issued the blue Air Force military uniform on loan at <u>no cost</u> which they wear once a week and conform to Air Force grooming and appearance standards.
- NOT an extension of the recruiting services of any branch of armed service.
- NOT directly connected with college- or university-level ROTC programs.
- NO REQUIREMENT to enter military service.
- Does NOT actively encourage any student to join military service.
